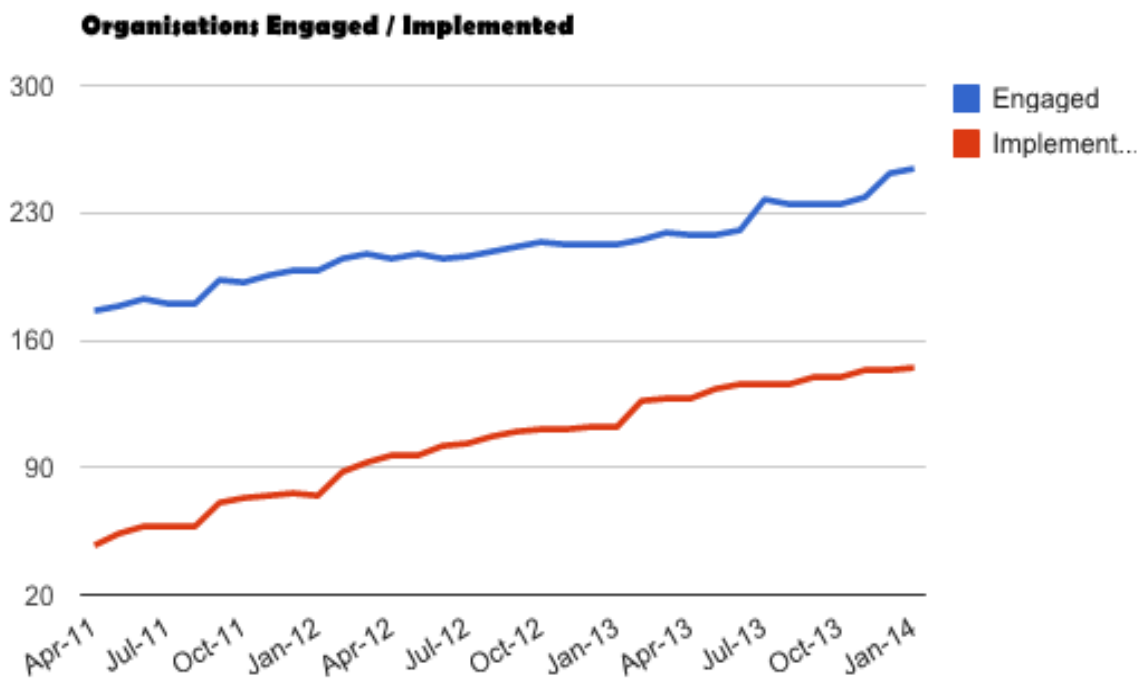

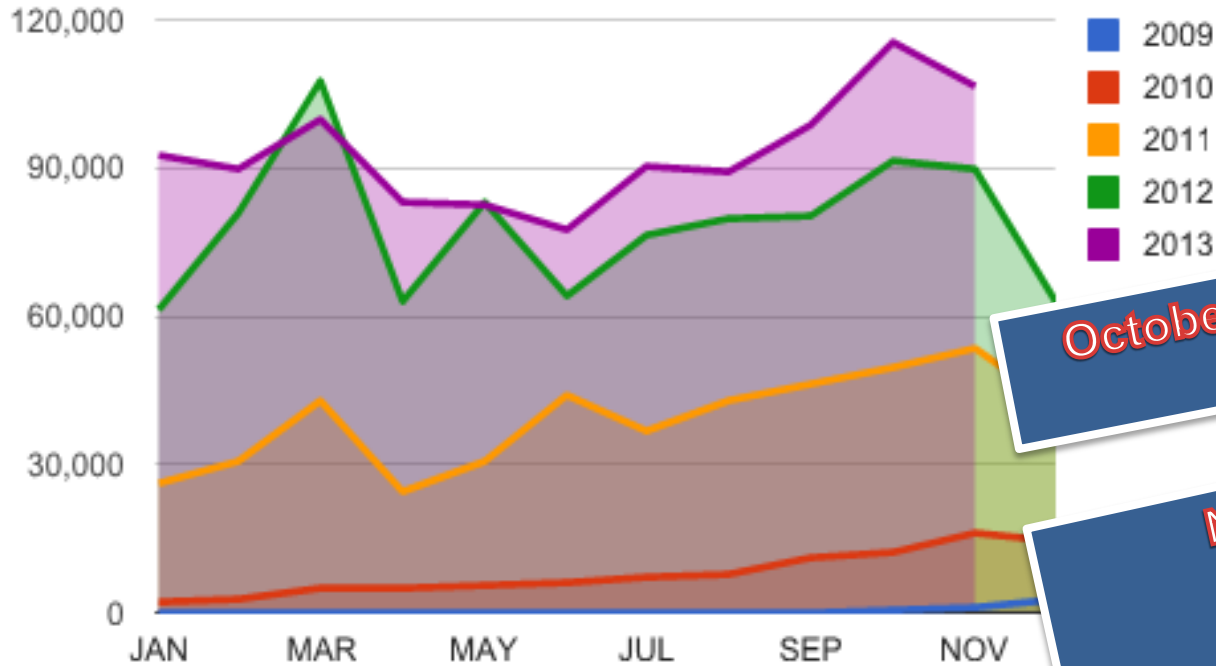
Q: Are Trusts still using OLM eLearning?

Yes! Implementations and interest in the system from NHS organisations continues to grow steadily.



Completions continue to grow month on month

Year on Year Comparison - Area

ESR Update

New SCORM Adaptors

UN1861 – Enables PCs with Java 1.7 installed to track e-learning successfully, and that this version has now been certified by Oracle.

R21 December – eLearning Communication Change

Oracle have changed a setting in OLM which alters the way in which communication is retrieved from ESR when someone plays e-Learning.

OLM previously only saved information that was in a session that was correctly ended (e.g. had LMSFinish called at the end).

Since December 13 any pages that have the 'commit' call after it will be saved, even if the session is not ended properly.

Minor Changes

- A tip was added to the Request Internet Access screen to explain what a user needs to do;
- A help button was added to the e-Learning Player toolbar, which will open a new window displaying information to help learners complete courses and trouble-shoot issues;
- Text was added to the e-Learning Player toolbar, next to the home icon, to advise users to exit using this icon
