

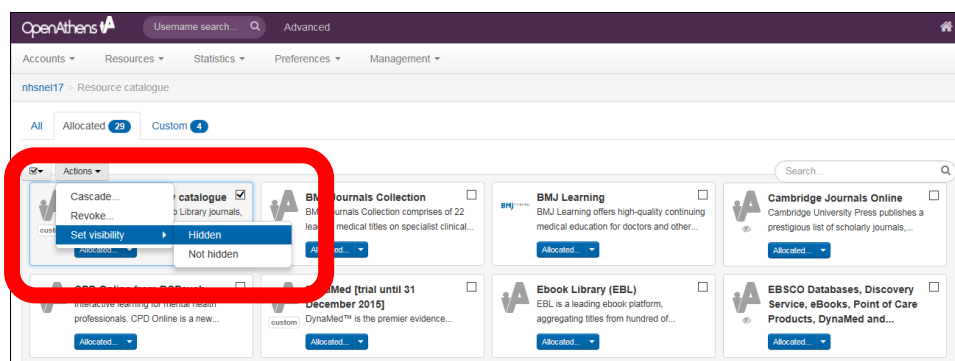
How to edit the resources list on the OpenAthens hub

The OpenAthens hub at <http://openathens.nice.org.uk/Hub> gives users a list of all the resources they have access to. As an OpenAthens admin, you have the ability to edit that list to make it more useful to users. You can hide resources from view and add custom links, for example to your library catalogue or other sites that your users might want links to.

1. Log into your OpenAthens admin area and go to “Resources -> Catalogue”.
2. Select the “Allocated” tab.

To hide a resource from the list:

- a. Tick the box in the upper right hand corner of the resource card. A button called “Actions” will appear at the top of the resource list. Click it and from the drop-down, select “Set visibility -> Hidden”.



To add a custom link (for example, to your library catalogue):

Select the “Custom” tab.

Click “Add...”

Click “Custom resource”, then “Configure”. Fill in the details. The Title field is what will appear in the user’s list on the OpenAthens hub so make sure you select something that will be useful. Here is the entry for our library catalogue, as an example:
